As much as we would like to think that Covid-19 is “behind us”, it is not. It continues to cause Delay’s and sometimes “no” responses to service calls. We are asking for your patience when maintenance requests require the expertise and parts from outside contractors. You will be notified when the contractor gives us a delivery/service date.

During the recent inspection by MSHDA (Michigan State Housing Development Authority), it was noted that several units had utility closets that were blocked. The utility closet contains the water heater and furnace for your apartment. It is imperative that there is nothing placed in front of the doors. Please see that all items placed in front of the utility room door are removed as soon as possible.

Recently, you received a letter from Pinnacle Quality Insight briefly describing the Resident Survey underway. Presbyterian Villages of Michigan (PVM) is very interested in your feedback. The last time your input was requested in a survey was 2019.
