

Recipes

Microwave Corn on the cob

1 ear of corn husked & cleaned
 Wet a paper towel and wring out
 Wrap around the ear of corn & place in
 microwave on a dinner plate
 Cook for 5 minutes
 Carefully remove the paper towel & Enjoy



Cinnamon & Sugar Chickpeas (Garbanzo Beans)

15 oz. can chickpeas
 1\2 Tbls olive oil
 1 Tbls honey
 1\2 tsp cinnamon
 1\8 tsp nutmeg
 1\8 tsp salt
 1\4 c sugar
 Drain chickpeas & coat with olive oil
 Bake approximately 45 min at 375
 (If chickpeas are still soft in center bake a little longer)
 Put remainder of ingredients in Ziploc bag (mix well)
 Then add the cooked chickpeas and give the bag a good
 shake to coat all the chickpeas
 Put chickpeas back in oven for ten minutes to
 caramelize the coating
 Let cool and enjoy


