6c popcorn, 1 $1\frac{1}{2}$ c mini pretzels

$1\frac{1}{2}$ c peanuts, $1\frac{1}{4}$ c honey

$1\frac{1}{3}$ c peanut butter, $1\frac{1}{2}$ c candy corn

$1\frac{1}{2}$ c Reese pieces, $1\frac{1}{4}$ tsp salt

$1\frac{1}{4}$ c sugar, 1 pack orange candy melts


