Pumpkin Bars

Pre heat oven 350 grease pan 15
1 1/2 x 10 1/2
2c sugar, 1/2 c veg oil, 1 16oz can
pumpkin, 4 eggs (beaten), 2 tsp
cinnamon, 1/2 c raisins, cream
cheese frosting
In large bowl beat, sugar, oil,
pumpkin & eggs on med for 1 min
then stir in remainder of
ingredients. Bake at 350 for 25-30
min or until tooth pick inserted
into center comes out clean.
Let cool the frost with cream cheese
frosting then refrigerate.

sliced, toss apple slices in 1/2c
brown sugar, 1/4 cookie mix in
large bowl until coated, place in
pan stir in remaining cookie mix
& baking powder until blended.
Stir in egg with fork until
evenly moisture
Sprinkle evenly over apples
drizzle butter over apple mixture
bake 45-50 min until apples are
tender and topping is golden
brown cool 15 min
Serve with ice cream






