

Macomb County Covid-19 cases have escalated and are back up in the highest level range. We had hoped we would get good news in regards to the number of cases by now but unfortunately that is not the case. We have to follow MDHHS rules and guidelines. Unfortunately, we still cannot open our doors to the public and IL residents. We are able to schedule visitation appointments with the residents and their families in our Assisted Living and Memory Care which are HFA licensed areas. Capman is Independent and falls under the same guidelines as all independent residents. I hesitate to write this as our situation changes daily if not by the hour sometimes. We recently have had staff members test positive. We cannot mandate that staff get the vaccine although many have gotten it. 98% of our HFA residents did get vaccinated. We will keep you posted as things change.

APRIL-HAPPY EASTER!!



GOOD FRIDAY AND EASTER– A CELEBRATION OF OUR LORD; WHAT HE HAS DONE AND IS ABOUT TO DO!

As was customary, the women of the Bible went to the tomb to anoint Jesus' body and were greeted by angels who told them, "He was not there; He has risen as he said he would."

His resurrection proves he was exactly who He said He was, confirms his authority and the importance of his teachings, while guaranteeing that the penalty for our sins has been paid in full for all believers and followers.

The entire public saw him on the cross. The spear in his side confirmed his death. He was buried in a tomb for 3 days, after which he rose and appeared to his disciples and over 500 witnesses.

The resurrection guarantees Jesus' return and of ultimate justice; that through him, we are justified ('Just-if-I'd' never sinned); sin will be judged, and death of our physical body is not final.

Our hope is in Christ and what took place at the cross. There is a new hope for a new life in Him. He WILL return to gather his children.

This is why we rejoice! Jesus laid down his life, yet- HE IS RISEN!






