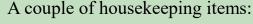
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Notes from the Administrator

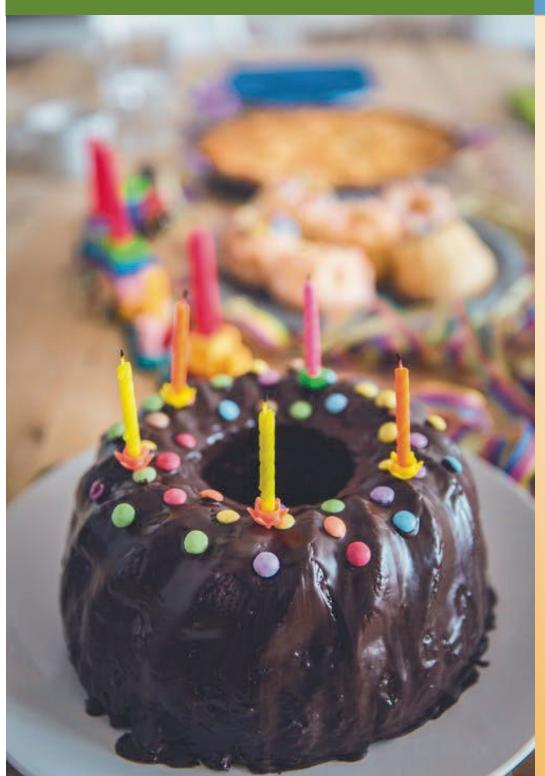
Please Note:

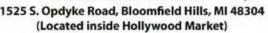

Star Drugs staff participates in medication therapy management programs sponsored by various medicare health plans.



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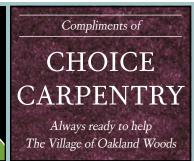
