Maintenance News

Today, we would like to discuss a vital aspect of home cleanliness that can sometimes go unnoticed—the cleaning of the jets under the rim of your toilet. We understand cleaning the toilet rim can be a challenging task, especially when it comes to tackling stubborn stains. Therefore, we are pleased to share a simplified method that utilizes the power of vinegar. To get started, gather the following tools:

- Toilet brush
- Hand mirror
- Latex or plastic gloves
- Pumice stone

Let's go through the cleaning process, which consists of four easy steps:

- Step 1: Begin by flushing the toilet, flush the toilet to remove any loose dirt or debris on the surface. This initial step will allow you to focus on the stain more effectively.
- Step 2: Vinegar is an exceptional cleaning agent for tackling mineral deposits on the toilet rim. Warm the toilet brush and apply the vinegar directly to the stains. For stubborn stains that require extra attention, gently scrub the affected area with the pumice stone.
- Step 3: Once the vinegar is applied, allow it to work its magic by letting it sit for approximately ten minutes.
- Step 4: After the vinegar has had sufficient time to work, thoroughly flush the toilet to remove the cleaning agent and any residual grime.





By following these four simple steps, you can effortlessly and effectively clean your toilet rim using vinegar and a pumice stone.

Lastly, we would like to remind you to exercise caution when cleaning a wooden toilet seat. Avoid allowing bathroom cleaners to sit on the enameled surface, as they may potentially damaged the paint. Furthermore, we would like to emphasize the importance of every resident owning a toilet plunger with a bell, as it is a valuable tool for any unexpected situation that may arise.


Please maintain the cleanliness of the gazebo by cleaning up after use.


