COVID-19 Statistics

- 2,659,164 – Positive Tests Worldwide
- 185,461 - Known Deaths Worldwide

- 842,624 - Positive Tests in U.S.
- 46,785 – Known Deaths in the U.S.

- 33,966 - Positive Tests in Michigan
- 2,813 – Known Deaths in Michigan

Federal Stimulus Bills

- Coronavirus Preparedness & Response Supplemental Appropriations Act (\$8.3 Billion)
 - \$6.2 Billion – U.S. Department of Health & Human Services
 - \$986 Million – U.S. Agency International Development
 - \$500 Million – Medicare Tele-Health Services
 - \$300 Million – U.S. Centers for Disease Control for global disease detection and response
 - \$264 Million – U.S. State Department operations
 - \$20 Million – Small Business Administration disaster loans

Federal Stimulus Bills

- Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) (\$3.47 Billion)
 - \$1 Billion – Unemployment Boost (\$600 weekly)
 - \$1 Billion – W.I.C. and Food Programs
 - \$64 Million – Native American Health Service
 - \$60 Million – U.S. Veterans Administration
 - 6.2% increase in Medicaid payments to states
 - Paid sick leave for companies employing less than 500

Federal Stimulus Bills

- CARES Act (\$2 Trillion)
 - \$350 Billion Small Business Administration loan
 - \$339.8 Billion – State & Local Government costs
 - \$300 Billion – Cash payments to taxpayers
 - \$260 Billion – Unemployment payments
 - \$100 Billion – Hospitals
 - \$80 Billion – F.D.A. for expediting drug approval
 - \$58 Billion – Airline Industry
 - \$20 Billion – Veterans Healthcare
 - \$16 Billion – PPE National Stockpile
 - \$15.5 Billion – SNAP food program
 - \$11 Billion – Treatment and diagnostics
 - \$ 8.8 Billion – School nutrition
 - \$4.3 Billion – U.S. Centers for Disease Control
 - \$450 Million – Food Programs

Federal Stimulus Bills

- CARES Act 2 or Coronavirus Interim (\$483 Billion)
 - \$320 Billion – Payment Protection Program (SBA Loans)
 - \$75 Billion – Hospitals for COVID-19 treatment costs
 - \$25 Billion – Broader testing
 - Requires the federal government to release a plan on how it will aid state's to increase testing.

Federal Stimulus Bills

- COVID-19 Stimulus Package 5 (\$2 Trillion ???)
 - Focused State & Local Government Relief
 - Infrastructure?

Federal Budget

- Some U.S. Senators now acknowledging \$2.7 Trillion has been added to the national debt in COVID-19 stimulus packages
